

Sell-Through Provisions Detailed in California Air Resources Board Advisory

The California Air Resources Board (CARB) has issued an advisory detailing the sell-through provisions contained in the Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) to Reduce Formaldehyde Emissions from Composite Wood Products approved in April 2007. Businesses required to comply with the ATCM include manufacturers, importers, distributors, fabricators, and retailers of composite wood products. The “sell-through” provisions that allow affected businesses to sell or use noncompliant composite wood products for specified periods of time after the effective dates in the ATCM are clarified in this advisory document.
